23. PROPOSED INCORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TRUCKEE OF ADJACENT SUBMERGED LANDS, NEVADA COUNTY; W 2400.109.

Mr. Robert C. Hight, Staff Counsel, explained that due to existing boundary disputes with regard to the bed of Donner Lake, in the opinion of Staff, it was not in the best interests of the State to approve this item.
Mr. James Porter, Attorney for the proponents of the proposed incorporation of the City of Truckee, questioned the Staff's recommendation on this matter. He explained that they could not proceed with the incorporation until approval from the State Lands Commission had been obtained. Chairman Cory suggested an alternative would be not to include the disputed area of Donner Lake.
Governor Dymally suggested an amendment be made to the application to the Local Agency Formation Commission which would separate Donner Lake from the proposed lands to be incorporated until the boundary dispute had been settled.
After consiäerable discussion, a motion was made by Governor Dymally and approved, that the Commission approve the incorporation with the condition that the bed of Donner Lake be deleted from the boundaries of the proposed city.
After consideration of Calendai Item 23 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted, as amended:
THE COMMISSION APPROVES THE PROPOSED BOUNDARIES OF PROPOSED INCORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TRUCKEE, PROVIDED THAT THE BED OF DONNER LAKE IS DELETED FROM THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED CITY AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A", ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; THE PROPOSED DESCRIPTION OF DONNER LAKE TO BE EXCLUDED IS TO BE SUPPLIED BY STAFF COUNSEL OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE, IF NO STATE LANDS ARE INCLUDED IN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED CITY, EXCLUDING THE BED OF DONNER LAKE, THEN SAID DESCRIPTION IS DISAPPROVED; AND AUTHORIZES STAFF COUNSEL TO GIVE THE REQUISITE NOTICES TO THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, THE PROPONENTS OF THE PROPOSED INCORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TRUCKEE, AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA OF SAID DISAPPROVAL.

PROPOSED INCORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TRUCKEE
OF ADJACENT SUBMERGED LANDS, NEVADA COUNTY

The City of Truckee proposes to incorporate certain submerged 1.ands owned by the State of California. Sectior 34302.3 of the Government Code provides for approval or disapproval by the State Lands Commission of the boundaries of an incorporation that includes tide or submerged lands that are owned by the State, and for reporting its determination to the County, City and to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County. Staff review of the map and of the legal description of the proposed incorporation has shown compliance with the provisions of said section.

Approval of the map and of the legal description is made pursuant to Section 34302.3 of the Government Code and does not constitute approval by the State, as owner of the submerged lands, of the proposed incorporation. This matter will be the subject of separate later consideration by the Commission.

In view of the fact that there presently exists unresolved tide and boundary problems at Donner Lake, it would not be in the best interest of the State to approve a description allowing incorporation of the City of Truckee so as to include Donner Lake. It is recommended that the Commission disapprove the description including Donner Lake. The Comission, at a later date, after the resolution of the title and boundary problems may wish to consider a new proposal for incorporation but until such time as the title and boundary problems are resolved, it would be in the best interest of the -State to disapprove a description involving Donner Lake.
