DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

County of Orange Harbors, Beaches and Park District 1901 Bayside Drive Newport Beach, California 92662

PROPOSED DREDGING:

Perform maintenance dredging (approximately 650 cubic yards total) at four locations (described in attached Exhibit "A") within Dana Point Harbor, Orange County.

SPOILS PLACEMENT:

All material dredged to be spoiled offshore at E.P.A. Disposal Site LA-3, or Orange County-owned Forester Canyon, upland refuse site.

OWNERSHIP:

State land granted to Orange County with minerals reserved to the State. Spoil disposal on the Federal OCS (E.P.A. site LA-3), or Orange County's Forester Canyon refuse site.

PURPOSE:

To maintain navigability in harbor and prevent flooding of County property on adjacent uplands.

CONSIDERATION:

The public interest, no royalty required.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT CONSIDERATION:

No Environmental Impact Report is required for the project. This project is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 4, which exempts a maintenance dredging operation.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Applicant has received statements of no interest from the following agencies:
 - A. South Coast Region Coastal Zone Commission.
 - B. Water Quality Control Board.
 - C. Department of Fish and Game.

The required U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit has not been issued; as such, the requested permit will be made conditional to the issuance of the Corps of Engineers Permit.

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2. Effective period of the permit shall be from January 15, 1976, to December 31, 1976.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS MAINTENANCE DREDGING PROJECT AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 2, SECTION 2907, CALIFORNIA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
- 2. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE COUNTY OF ORANGE, HARBORS, BEACHES AND PARK DISTRICT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 650 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM FOUR STORM DRAIN OUTFALLS WITHIN DANA POINT HARBOR, ORANGE COUNTY, SUCH AREA BEING DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; AT NO ROYALTY RATE, THE CONSIDERATION BEING THE PUBLIC BENEFIT AND TO SPOIL APPROXIMATELY 350 CUBIC YARDS OF SUCH DREDGED MATERIAL EITHER AT EPA DISPOSAL SITE LA-3 OR ORANGE COUNTY-OWNED FORESTER CANYON REFUSE SITE, AND TO SPOIL THE REMAINING 300 CUBIG YARDS ON TIDELANDS GRANTED TO ORANGE COUNTY WITHIN DANA POINT HARBOR; EFFECTIVE FROM JANUARY 15, 1976, TO DECEMBER 31, 1976; SUCH PERMIT TO BE CONDITIONAL TO THE ISSUANCE AND REQUIREMENTS OF A PERMIT FROM THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, AND ANY OTHER PERMITS, REQUIREMENTS OR LIMITATIONS AS SET OR AS MAY BE SET BY FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
