## DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

City of Richmond

Civic Center

PROPOSED DREDGING:

To perform maintenance dredging (approximately 16,000 cubic yards) on two acres (described in Fxhibit "A" attached) of tide and submerged lands in San Francisco Bay at Richmond, adjacent to terminal 4, Contra Costa County.

SPOILS PLACEMENT:

All spoils to be placed in the Department of Army, Corps of Engineers Alcatraz Island Disposal

OWNERSHIP:

Dredge area is granted to the City or Richmond with minerals reserved by the State of California. Spoils area is within grant to the City of San

PURPOSE:

To return berthing area to its original depth of 35 feet below mean lower low water which will provide adequate depth for ships using the wharf.

CONSIDERATION:

Public interest, no royalty required.

HNVIRONMENTAL IMPACT CONSIDERATION:

An Buvironmental Impact Report is not required. This project is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 4, which exempts maintenance
