AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 2,817 square foot parcel of submerged land in Lake Tahoe near Homewood, Placer County.

LAND USE: Existing pier with two covered boat berths and sundeck for recreational boating.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE: Initial period: 5 years, from October 29, 1974.

Surety Bond: \$1,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$100 per annum.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: \$100 fixed rental for this type of permit.

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PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicants are owners of upland.
