BACKGROUND:

The PRC 4244.1 provides that the State may adjust the annual rental at a different amount for the 5-year term following the fifth anniversary of the lease, effective on such anniversary date. This is a non-commercial lease for a term of 49 years from February 26, 1965, with an annual rent of \$150 for the maintenance of a floating wharf.

The value of the land covered by the lease has been considered, and it has been determined that the minimum rental rate should apply. The lessee was notified of the amount within the time constraints set by his lease.
