MONITORING OF POSSIBLE GHOLOGIC HAZARDS, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

Surveys are conducted twice each year, February and August, for the purpose of monitoring changes in the ground elevation of the Long Beach tidelands and adjacent areas. The Division staff reviews and interprets this survey information. Staff study of the August 1975 survey data substantiates that no subsidence of the land surface has occurred as a result of operations in the Long Beach Unit.

Additionally, a network of five seismic monitoring stations is being operated for the Long Beach Unit, under contract, by the Geophysical Laboratory of the University of Southern California. No seismic event originated within the Long Beach Unit area during the subject period, February to August, 1975.

The Division will continue to report to the Commission, semiannually, the results of the ground elevation surveys and will advise of any significant change in the quiescent seismic condition.
