PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT:

State Department of Navigation and Ocean Development 1416 - Ninth Street Sacramento, California 95814

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A parcel of submerged land in the State owned bed of Piper Slough containing 0.115 acre adjacent to the State recreation area know as Ruth Property Little Franks Tract, Contra Costa County,

LAND USE:

A shore access dock to provide 6-boat slips for public use.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 49-years, from April 1, 1976.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit to apply only for as long as public use and access is free with State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITA TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is permittee of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2,

B. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3 Arts. 1, 2, 10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site of estimated to be \$450.
 - This project is situated on State land identified as environmentally significant, pursuant to Public Resources Gode 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class B: Limited Use. The project is determined to be a compatible use consistent with identified significant environmental values. Staff has cleared this project with the Department of Fish and Game, the agency which nominated the subject land for a Class "B" designation.

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3. A Negative Declaration was prepared by the Department of Navigation and Ocean Development, pursuant to CEQA and implementing regulations. A Notice of Determination has been received.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 2. CERTIFY THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED WHE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION.
- 3. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
- 4. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE APPLICATION WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 ET SEQ. OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
- 5. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF NAVIGATION AND OCEAN DEVELOPMENT OF A 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM APRIL 1, 1976, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND RENEFIT TO APPLY ONLY FOR AS LONG AS PUBLIC USE AND ACCESS IS FREE WITH STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR A 6-BOAT SHORE ACCESS BE IN THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

S 30° W, 50.0 feet; thence N 60° W, 100.00 feet; thence N 30° E, 50,0 feet; thence S 60° E, 100 feet to the point of beginning.
