A parcel of submerged land in the State owned bed of the Sacramento River, lying northerly of and adjacent to Ida Island (Swamp and Overflowed Land Survey 508), Sacramento County, California, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of trailer space No. 60 in the mobile home park of Vieira's Resort on said Ida Island, said pin being in a concrete curb on the northerly side of an unnamed gravel street and westerly along said curb, 142 feet more or less from the westerly bank of a dredged boat docking lagoon; thence westerly along the south line of said trailer space, 14 feet to the TRUM POINT OF REGINNING; thence northerly along a line parallel with the east line of said trailer space, 130 feet; thence westerly at right angles to said parallel line, 28 feet; thence southerly along a line parallel with the vest line of said trailer space to the south line thereof; thence easterly along said south line to the true point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Sacramento River.
