APPLICANT:

Morrison and Weatherly Chemical Products P. O. Box 296 Lone Fine, California 93545

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 49.89 acre parcel in the dry lake bed of Owens Lake, Invo County.

LAND USE:

For the continued maintenance of a right of way for a road and drainage ditches.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: 10 years from July 12, 1966.

Renewal options: Three successive periods of 10 years each, and one additional period of 9 years.

Consideration:

\$157.50.

TERMS OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT RENEWAL:

Initial period: 10 years, from July 12, 1976. Renewal options: Two successive periods of 10 years each, and one additional period of 9 years.

Surety bond \$2,000

Public liability insurance: \$1,000,000 single limit for bodily injury and property damage.

CONSIDERATION:

\$400 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: 8% of appraised value of Fand.

PREREQUISIVE TERMS, FERS AND EXPLOSES: Applicant is owner of upland.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This lease, for right of way purposes; to Morrison and Weatherly covers an existing facility which is used in conjunction with their operation of a chemical processing plant, all of which is maintained in a good and acceptable manner.
- 2. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Gal. Adm. Code 2907(a) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline crosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

- 2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO MORRISON AND WEATHERLY CHEMICAL PRODUCTS OF A 10-YEAR RIGHT OF WAY LEASE FROM JULY 12, 1976, WITH LESSEE'S OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO SUCCESSIVE PERIODS OF 10 YEARS EACH, AND ONE ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF 9 YEARS; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMGUNT OF \$400, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$2,000 SURETY BOND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABTLITY INSURANCE IN AMOUNTS OF \$1,000,000 FOR BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE; FOR THE CONTINUED MAINTENANCE OF A RIGHT OF WAY FOR A ROAD AND DRAINAGE DITCHES ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ON FILE WITH THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS.
