BACKGROUND:

The Division received Department of the Army, Corps of Engineers, Bublic Notice 5207, dated May 17, 1974, relative to an existing floating dock in the Sacramento River at Assessor's Parcel No. 030-141-03, City of Sacramento, Sacramento County. By letter dated June 6, 1974, Mr. Hill was advised that it will be necessary for him to secure a permit on lease from the State Lands Commission.

The Secretary for Resources, by letter dated July 16, 1974, advised the U. S. Army, Corps of Engineers, "The State Lands Division states it would be necessary for applicant to secure a permit or lease from the State Lands Commission. Information relative to application requirements forwanded to applicant by letter dated June 5, 1974. To date a reply has not been received by the Commission."

By lotters dated July 3, 1975, September 5, 1975, and April 29, 1976, all of which were by certified mail - return receipt requested - Mr. Hill was advised that the exection or maintenance of structures on State owned land under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission without written authorization is in violation of the Public Resources Gode.

Mr. Hill was personally contacted on January 21, 1976. Mr. Hill was very uncooperative and would not rationally discuss this matter with the State Lands Division representative.

In April, 1976, the Division conducted a field investigation which revealed:

Since June 6, 1974, Mr. Hill has not responded to the communications of the State Lands Division.
