ESTABLISHMENT OF A RIVER MARINA AND WATERWAY LIAISON COMMITTEE

On February 13, 1975, the Commission announced an intensive program to bring under lease those persons using State tide and submerged lands without a permit. This program has concentrated most heavily on the areas of Donner Lake, Lake Tahoe, Sacramento River, Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and San Diego County bays and lagoons along with some small areas as appropriate. The immediate results of this program have been to attract the concern of many informal associations and groups of homeowners and marina operators involved in the use of waterfront land and State waterways.

The Commission and Division representatives have made numerous public appearances before these associations and groups to explain the position of the State and the various statutes and codes which are applicable to the use of State tide and submerged lands. In spite of these efforts to explain and elaborate on the State's position, some areas of confusion and misunderstanding still appear to exist with many potential applicants and lessees.

In order to help solve this problem and to expand the Commission's visibility to the public in these areas, use of a liaison committee is suggested utilizing representatives of the various groups and public agencies to work with staff in a continuing role of developing information explaining the Commission's role and to provide input to the Commission from time to time on activities and situations along the river.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ESTABLISH A RIVER MARINA AND WATERWAYS LIAISON COMMITTEE TO BE MADE UP OF OPERATORS AND USERS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER AND OTHER INTERESTED AGENCIES OR PRIVATE PARTIES -- THE COMMITTEE TO WORK WITH STAFF AND PERIODICALLY PROVIDE INPUT TO THE COMMISSION WITH REGARD TO ACTIVITIES ALONG THE RIVER.
