### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

By memorandum dated November 20, 1970, the Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, applied to the Commission for a reservation of State sovereign lands for a bridge crossing the Salinas River, between Castroville and Marina, Monterey County.

Processing of the transaction was held up pending a determination of the State's interest in the Salinas River. During the intervening period, the bridge construction project was completed. The Department of Transportation has now submitted an acceptable plat of the reserved lands.

The project is not situated on State land identified as environmentally significant

pursuant to PRC Section 6370.1. While the existing bed of the Salinas River is classified as a Class "A" - Restricted Use parcel, the original bed of the Salinas River, now filled, is not classified as a significant parcel.

Inasmuch as the bridge has already been constructed, the project is categorically exempt from current environmental impact reporting regulations.
