MINOR COMMERCIAL LEASE

A 35' x 260' (.209 acre) parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Maintenance of floating boat dock.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 10 years, from September 1, 1976.

Surety bond:

\$1,000.

Public liability insurance: \$500 000 combined single limit.

CONSIDERATIONS

\$225 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth annive-sary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$225 minimum rental for thi, type of lease or permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, HESS AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee has been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
