CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AND OIL AND GAS LEASES

Standard Oil Company of California, holds a number of leases with the State Lands Commission. These leases are listed and abstracted on Exhibit "A".

On or about January 1, 1977, Standard Oil of California proposes to assign all its interest in said leases to a wholly-owned subsidiary corporation, Chevron, U.S.A., Inc.

As part consideration for this multiple assignment, Standard has agreed to amend PRC 4497.1 to insert a five-year rent review which had been omitted in that lease. The proposed amendment is the subject of a companion Calendar Item before the Commission at this meeting.

This transaction is not a project within the meaning defined in 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15037 and PRC 21065.

Accordingly, an environmental assessment for this transaction is not required.

 - A. AN ASSIGNMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF ASSIGNMENT WILL BE COMPLETED, EXECUTED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE ASSIGNOR AND ASSIGNEE IN RESPECT OF EACH LEASE AND EASEMENT AND A FULLY EXECUTED AND ACKNOWLEDGED COPY OF EACH ONE WILL BE DELIVERED TO THE COMMISSION.
 - B. THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE RECEIVED A CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA SECRETARY OF STATE AS TO THE ASSIGNEE.
