A recent boundary survey conducted by the **r**. State Lands Division in conjunction with the Port District indicated that this parcel was not included in the grant to the Port District. The Port District assumes that this property was included in the area originally granted, and the parcel was included in their plans to accommod'ate a potential industrial user.
