AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED WITH TITLE LIFTGATION. AT PETE'S HARBOR, REDWOOD CITY, SAN MATEO COUNTY

The parcel of land now occupied and used as Peters Harbor was included within the State Swamp and Overflowed Lands Patent of Location No. 4166, the Certificate of Purchase was issued on or about August 16, 1930.

Bocation 4466, Was traversed by Smith Slough, a major tidal and navigable waterway which has continously existed since before statehood to the present time and upon which the marina is focated.

The patent would appear to have been issued in direct violation of California Constitution Article XV, Section 3, and would therefore appear to be void, in whole or in part.

The private occupants claim ownership of the parcel free of any right, title, or interest of the State.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED THAT STAFF COUNSEL OF THE STATE LANDS DIVISION AND/OR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PROCEED WITH SUCH LITUGATION AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH, IDENTIFY, AND PROTECT THE STATE'S RIGHT, TITLE, AND INTEREST IN THE REAL PROPERTY INCLUDED WITHIN SWAMP AND OVERFLOWED LANDS LOCATION 4166.
