exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant t Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class B, which authorizes limited use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

The marina facilities were constructed prior to May 1960 and have been in trespass of State land since completed. Although staff had attempted to bring these facilities under lease, efforts were not successful due to the many changes in the upland owner ship.

The present owners of this marina facility have been very cooperative with staff in negotiating a commercial lease. They have been in possession of the marina for only a few months and have agreed to all of the terms proposed by staff. Staff feels that it would be unprofitable from a time standpoint to pursue the previous owners in any attempts to recover back rent.

4. The marina facilities have existed for many years without causing any adverse effects on the environment.
