TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 49 years from November 1, 1976.

CONSIDERATION:

The public health and safety with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is owner of upland.

Processing costs have been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- A final environmental impact report was prepared by the City of Oakdale pursuant to CEQA and implementing regulations. A Notice of Determination has been received.
- 2. This project is situated on State land identified as environmentally significant, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Cluss A: Restricted Use. The project was coordinated with those agencies making the nomination; they find this use to be compatible with the identified significant environmental values.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$75.
