DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: County of Sonoma
2555 Mendocino Avenue
Santa Rosa, California 95401

PROPOSED DREDGING:
The proposed project is to remove an existing dike which will involve the removal of approximately 3,000 cubic yards of sand, clay and topsoil from an area of sovereign lands within Bodega Bay, Sonoma County.

SPOILS PLACEMENT:
The material will be removed by carryall and placed on County-owned uplands northerly from and adjacent to the dike area.

OWNERSHIP:
The removal area is within an area granted to the County of Sonoma (Stats. 1951), with minerals reserved to the State.

PURPOSE:
To remove an obstruction (the dike) which prevents the full tidal action in order to rejuvenate the existing marsh area behind the dike.

CONSIDERATION: Public benefit, no royalty required.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATION:
1. The County of Sonoma, lead agency, has processed a negative declaration for the project, on file with the office of the State Lands Commission and by reference made a part hereof. The County states that the requirements of CEQA have been fulfilled.
2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class B: Limited Use. Staff review indicates that there will be no significant detrimental effect upon the identified environmental values. The staff of the Division has received no adverse comments on this project.

OTHER PERTINENT DATA:
1. Applicant has requested permission to perform the removal from the following agencies:

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- a. U.S. Corps of Engineers.
- b. California Coastal Zone Conservation Commission.
- c. Regional Water Quality Control Board.
- d. California Department of Fish and Game.

The permit will be issued contingent upon the applicant securing permission from those agencies.

2. The upland area to receive the spoils is diked to prevent runoff from returning to the waterway.

3. Effective period of the permit to be January 26, 1977 to December 31, 1977.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT BUT THAT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PREPARED.

2. CERTIFY THAT THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN COMPLIED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT OF 1970, AS AMENDED, AND THE STATE GUIDELINES, AND THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN.

3. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT DETRIMENTAL EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.

4. DETERMINE THAT THE GRANTING OF THIS PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 ET SEQ., OF THE PUBLIC SOURCES CODE.

5. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE COUNTY OF SONOMA TO REMOVE APPROXIMATELY 3,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED GRANTED LANDS IN BODEGA BAY; SUCH AREA BEING DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; AT NO ROYALTY, THE CONSIDERATION BEING THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, AND TO SPOIL SUCH MATERIAL AT THE UPLAND DISPOSAL SITE NO.1; EFFECTIVE JANUARY 31, 1977 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1977; SUCH PERMISSION BEING SUBJECT TO ISSUANCE OF ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS AS SET OR AS MAY BE SET BY STATE, FEDERAL OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

A strip of tide and submerged land 50.00 feet in width, in Bodega Harbor, County of Sonoma, State of California, being 25.00 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at the intersection of California State Highway No. 1 and Doran Park Road which lies approximately 1.5 miles southeasterly of the town of Bodega Bay, California; thence in a westerly direction, along said Doran Park Road, 3,600 feet more or less to the intersection of the southwesterly projection of the centerline on an earthfill dike and being the POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described centerline; thence northeasterly along the centerline of said earthfill dike, 1,100 feet to the terminus of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Bodega Harbor.
