GENERAL PERMIT
PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: California Department of Fish and Game
350 Golden Shore
Long Beach, California 90802

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 6.428 area circular parcel of submerged
land in the Pacific Ocean near Oxnard,
Ventura County.

LAND USE: Placement and maintenance of an artificial
fishing reef.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 49 years from September 1,
1977.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit with the State
reserving the right at any time to set
a monetary rental if the Commission finds
such action to be in the State's best interest.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:
A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.
B. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3,
Arts. 1, 2, 6.5, 10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
1. The annual rental value of the site
is estimated to be \$5,000.
2. A negative declaration was prepared
by the State Department of Fish and
Game, pursuant to CEQA and implementing
regulations. A Notice of Determination
has been received.
3. The project is situated on State land
identified as possessing significant
environmental values pursuant to Public
Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified
in a use category, Class B which authorizes
Limited Use.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C1. (CONTD)

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This project is for the expansion of an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

4. All other permits required by other regulatory agencies are progressing in a routine manner.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT BUT THAT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PREPARED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME, ON MARCH 8, 1977.
2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5 OF TITLE 2 OF THE CAL. ADM. CODE.
3. CERTIFY THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION.
4. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
5. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
6. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 49 YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 1977; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR THE PLACEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF AN ARTIFICIAL FISHING REEF ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
