GENERAL PERMIT  
PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: California Department of Fish and Game  
350 Golden Shore  
Long Beach, California 90802

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 10.142 acre parcel of submerged land  
in the Pacific Ocean near Huntington Beach,  
Orange County.

LAND USE: The operation of an artificial fishing  
reef.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Initial period: 49 years from September  
1, 1977.

CONSIDERATION: The public benefit with the State reserving  
the right at any time to set a monetary  
rental if the Commission finds such action  
to be in the State's best interest.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:  
A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.  
B. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3,  
Arts. 1, 2, 6.5, 10  
& 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:  
1. An Environmental Impact Report is not  
required. This project is categorically  
exempt from CEQA because actions taken  
by regulatory agencies as authorized  
by State law to assure the maintenance,  
restoration, or enhancement of a natural  
resource where the regulatory process  
involves procedures for protection  
of the environment, for these same  
reasons this project is consistent  
with the Commission's Coastal Zone  
Regulations.

2. This project is situated on State land  
identified as possessing significant  
environmental values pursuant to Public

Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

3. Permits from other regulatory agencies, having jurisdiction over this project, are proceeding in a routine manner.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PRC 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
3. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5 OF TITLE 2 OF THE CAL. ADM. CODE.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 1977; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR THE OPERATION OF AN ARTIFICIAL FISHING REEF ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
