EXTENSION OF BAIR ISLAND
ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY AGREEMENT

An Environmental Study Agreement, P.R.C. 4894, executed December 2, 1973, between Mobil Oil Estates (Bair Island Investments) Limited and the State, called for the State, under an interagency task force, to determine the environmental qualities of Bair Island and the compatible uses thereof. At the conclusion of the study and within three years and seven months, Mobil was to grant at least 60 acres of ecologically sensitive land to the State.

Because of the recently voiced concerns of the City of Redwood City and of Mobil, it will be necessary for the staff to circulate to the task force their comments for analysis and action. An extension of the agreement until January 1, 1978 has been stipulated to by Mobil. The staff recommends such extension.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION GRANT AN EXTENSION OF THE BAIR ISLAND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY AGREEMENT (P.R.C. 4894) FROM OCTOBER 3, 1977 TO AND INCLUDING JANUARY 1, 1978.
