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## CITY OF STOCKTON

THE CITY OF STOCKTON HAS REQUESTED THAT THE COMMISSION EXPRESS ITS INTENT TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE CITY FOR A LEASE COVERING AN AREA OF 10 MILE SLOUGH ADJACENT TO THE CITY'S BUCKLEY COVE DEVELOPMENT WHICH IS IN AN AREA OF THE ORIGINAL BED OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER PREVIOUSLY GRANTED TO . THE CITY.

BECAUSE OF THE WITHDRAWAL CAST MONTH OF A PRIVATE APPLICANT'S APPLICATION ON 10 MILE SLOUGH NEAR BUCKLEY COVE IN THE CITY OF STOCKTON, IT IS THE INTENT OF STAFF TO NEGOTIATE A REVENUE PRODUCING LEASE COVERENG THE SAME AREA WITH OUR REMAINING APPLICANT, THE CITY OF STOCKTON. NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS WOULD ANY MEGOTIATIONS FOR A COMMERCIAL LEASE AND WILL REQUIRE A MONETARY RENTAL FROM THE CITY OF STACKTON.
