DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST

The State of California, State Lands Commission is a party to a quiet title action brought by Gaylor L. and Laura L. Mailhot, a husband and wife, entitled <u>Mailhot v. City</u> of <u>Sutter Creek</u>, et al., filed in the Superior Court of Amador County No. 9781, involving a tract of land on the Old Amador Trail.

Upon examination of the Commission's records partiment to the area, it was ascertained that there is no interest held by the State Lands Commission as to the tract of land described as Parcel 1 as set forth and delineated on Parcel and 2, Block 25, Sutter Creek Townsite and Old Amador Trail filed for record March 19, 1976 in Book "26" of Maps and Plats, Page 45, Amador County Records.

Inasmuch as the suit involves land over which the Commission has no jurisdiction, it is recommended that a disclaimer be filed on behalf of the State Lands Commission disclaiming any right, title or interest in the above described lot.
