TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 10 years from May 1, 1978.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$100,000.

CONSIDERATION:

\$70 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on

each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$70 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and first year's rental have

been received.

The upland property is unimproved; therefore it does not fall under the

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2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class R, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

3. Total area covered by permit is 2,780 sq. ft.; however, renual is calculated on the area waterward of low water (1,920 sq. ft.).
