CUTTING BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN PRC 5471 STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE, KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST

At its meeting of September 29, 1977, the State Lands Commission authorized the staff, in part, to negotiate a temporary cutting boundary agreement with the United States Forest Service for the timbered school hands in Lot 1, Section 16, TION, R8E, HM, containing approximately 33 acres in Siskiyou County (refer to Minute Item No. 24, September 29, 1977).

The staff has negotiated an agreement for a timber cutting boundary with the United States Forest Service, the owner of the surrounding land, following the establishment of reasonable property lines on the ground to the satisfaction of both parties. The content of the agreement is similar to other such agreements previously approved by the Commission.

This temporary cutting boundary agreement will allow both the State and the United States Forest Service to subsequently remove the salvageable timber from their respective ownerships without a time consuming survey. Because of the lack of monumentation in the vicinity a full survey would be extremely costly.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION: This project is situated on school lands not identified as possessing significant environmental values. A staff review of available environmental information indicates no reason to identify the subject school land parcel as having such values at this time.


EXHIBIT: A. Location Map.
