APPROVAL OF THE EMERGENCY SALE OF INSECT-KILLED TIMBER

High Sierra Land and Timber Company has offered \$600 for the purchase of 9 bark beetles infested Ponderosa Pine trees on a 2 acre area of State school land in Lot 1, Section 36, TI8N R7E, MDM; near Bullards Bar Reservoir in Yuba County. The small volume of timber on State land is not sufficient to be economically logged on its own. High Sierra is logging beetle-killed timber on adjacent United States Forest Service land and can harvest the State's timber as part of their operation. Since the removal of the trees is important to reduce the chance of spread of the infestation a sale to High Sterra. The \$600 sales price for the 10,000 board feet is reasonable considering the size and condition of the trees involved.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An EIR is not required. This project is an emergency action to prevent or mitigate loss through the salvage of insect-killed timber.
- 2. This project is on school land not identified as possessing significant environmental values. A staff review of available environmental information indicates no reason to identify the parcel as having such values at this time.
