OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class "B" which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

- Rental is proposed from the effective date of the permit without obligation to pay rental for prior periods. The applicant requested a permit by letter dated October 24, 1972. The issuance of such permit has been delayed, pending completion of a boundary agreement between the Commission and the Sacramento Port Center. In addition, the Yacht Club has had to postpone construction of upland facilities by reason of uncertain boundaries, and construction costs have increased substantially during the interim. The staff believes the Yacht Club has borne financial loses from such matters and that these losses were beyond the control of the applicant, and that State action has been a partial cause thereof. The staff thus recommends a rental obligation applicable from the effective date of the permit forward.
 - 3. The applicant is a non-profit organization; no commercial activity is carried on by the Sacramento Yacht Club. The proposed rental for the club's use of the subject property is consistent with basis of rental charges in other State Lands Commission permits for non-profit organizations.
 - 4. The effective date of the proposed permit will be the recordation date of Boundary Line Agreement No. 168 in Yolo County. Staff will advise the Commission of such date after recordation is completed and will annotate such information in Commission records:

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED IN LEASES ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH BOUNDARY AND TITLE SETTLEMENTS.

- 3. FIND THAT IT IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE TO WALVE RENTAL WHICH MAY HAVE ACCRUED PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF BLA 168, IN CONSIDERATION OF BLA 168 AND WAIVE SUCH RENTS.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE SACRAMENTO YACHT CLUB OF A 25-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT FECREATIONAL USE FROM DATE OF RECORDATION OF BOUNDARY LINE AGREEMENT NO. 168; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,240, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$5,000 SURETY BOND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN AMOUNTS OF \$300,000 PER OCCURRENCE FOR BODILY INJURY AND \$100,000 FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE, FOR A DOCKAGE FACILITY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
