Operation and maintenance of 3 existing LAND USE: 12 KV overhead power lines. TERMS OR ORIGINAL LEASE: Initial period: 15 years from April 25, 1963. Renewal options: 3 successive periods of 10 years each. Consideration: \$57.14 per annum. TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE: Initial period: 10 years from April 25, 1978. Renewal options: 2 successive periods of 10 years each. Special: Liability insurance: Combined single limit of \$1,000,000. CONSIDERATION: \$100 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease. BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: \$100 minimum rental for this type of lease. PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is permittee of upland.
