OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to a jacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff review indicated that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

- 3. This facility is exempt from the requirements of Article 6.5 of Title 2 of the Cal. Adm. Code. Because this facility is not a development within the meaning of Section 25/3 of Title 2 of the Cal Adm. Code and Section 30105 of the P.R.C.
- 4. The volumetric rental alternative was considered, but found to be inappropriate in this case, due to insufficient volume.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF AN AMENDED 10-YEAR GENERAL LEASE INDUSTRIAL RIGHT-OF-WAY USE FROM MARCH 26, 1979, WITH THE LESSEE'S OPTION TO RENEW FOR 2 SUCCESSIVE PERIODS OF 10 YEARS EACH; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,210, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE, COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$1,000,000; FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF SUBMARINE PIPELINES AND POWER CABLE ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
