CANDLESTICK POINT STATE RECREATION AREA (W 21933)

THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT SEVERAL RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ALONG THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY SHORELINE AT THE CANDLESTICK POINT STATE RECREATION AREA. IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST FOR A PERMIT APPLICATION, DIRECTOR CAHILL HAS PLEDGED HIS DEPARTMENT'S COOPERATION IN APPLYING FOR A PERMIT, BUT REQUESTS DURING THE INTERIM STATE LANDS COMMISSION PERMISSION TO PROCEED WITH PIER REPAIR WORK FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- 1. THE PROJECT IS AN IMMEDIATE PUBLIC USE FACILITY (I.P.U.) AND IS SCHEDULED FOR COMPLETION BY AUGUST 1979.
- 2. DELAY IN PROJECT COMPLETION COULD RESULT

 IN LOSS OF AVAILABLE ON-SITE COMMUNITY LABOR
 FORCES.
- 3. EXISTING PIER FACILITY (OUTSIDE STATE LANDS COMMISSION LEASING JURISDICTION) REQUIRES IMMEDIATE REPAIR, BUT IS PART OF OVERALL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION.

DUE TO THE URGENCY OF THE REQUEST, WITH YOUR

CONSENT I WILL ADVISE DIRECTOR CAHILL THAT HE MAY PROCEED

WITH THE PIER REPAIR WORK. A FORMAL PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

COVERING THE FACILITIES WILL BE PROCESSED BY STAFF AS SOON AS

POSSIBLE.
