GENERAL PERMIT
RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT: Benjamin J. and
Marjorie J. Verdusco
236 Main Street
Colusa, California 95932

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.03 acre parcel of submerged land in
the Sacramento River at the City of Colusa,
Colusa County.

LAND USE: Operation and maintenance of an existing
floating dock.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 3 years from June 1,
1979.

Public liability insurance, combined single
limit coverage of \$100,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$40 per annum.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$40 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee of upland.

Filing fee and first year's rent have been
received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

3. This permit is issued for a 3-year term to coincide with the length of the applicant's upland encroachment permit from the City of Colusa, the upland owner.

A parcel of submerged land in the State owned bed of the Sacramento River at the City of Colusa, Colusa County, California, more particularly described as follows:

All that land lying immediately beneath and extending 10 feet from all sides of an existing floating dock, said dock being adjacent to the right bank of the Sacramento River and lying northerly of block 3 as shown on the map of the City of Colusa, filed in book 1 of maps at page 45, Colusa County records.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Sacramento River.

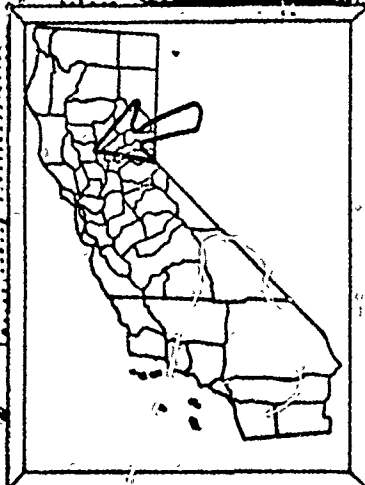
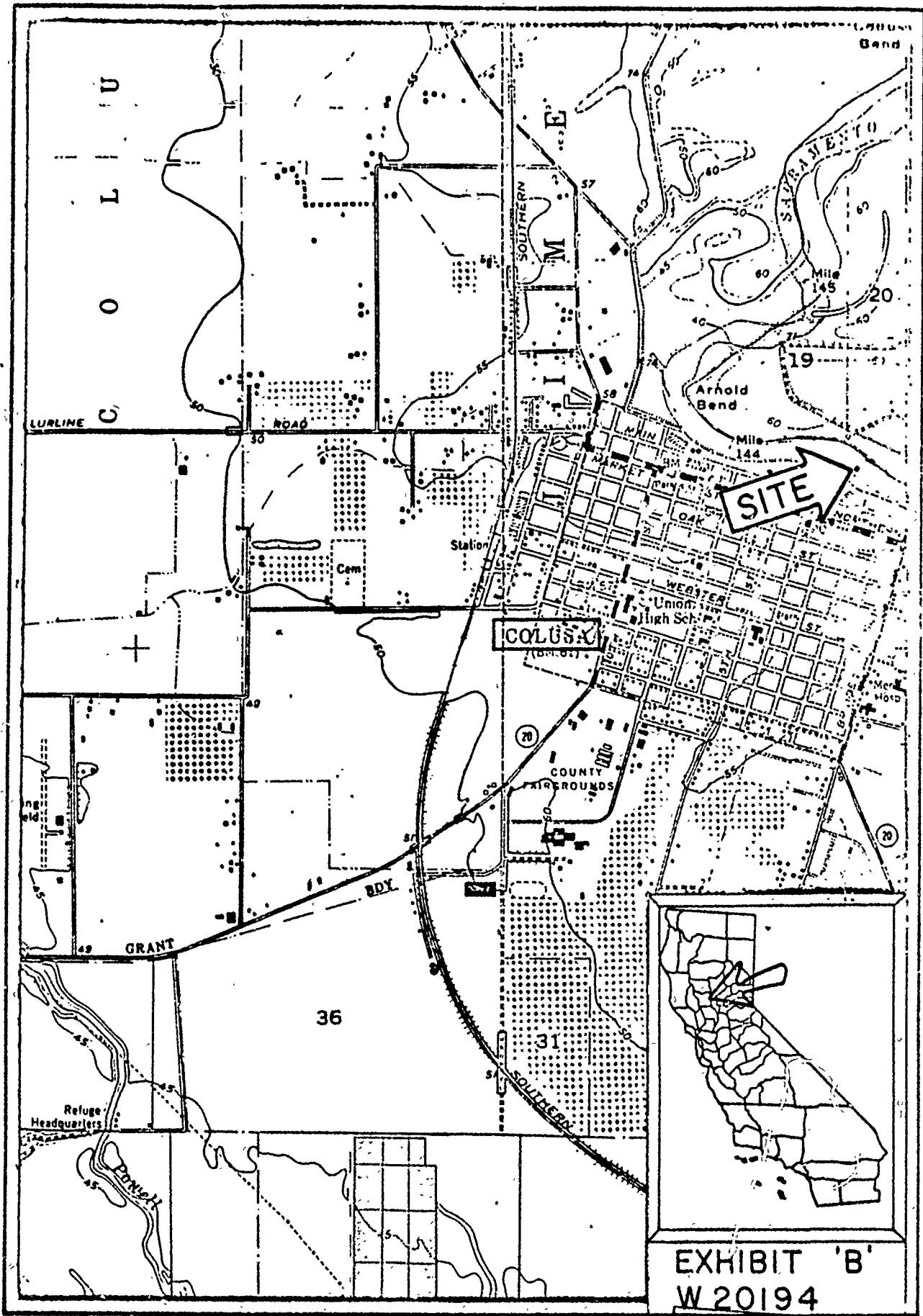
