DENIAL OF APPLICATIONS
(AB 884)

Pursuant to Chapter 1200, Statutes of 1977 (AB 884) the following applications for State Lands Commission lease or permit are submitted for denial. These applications were deemed complete in accordance with Commission approved criteria, and the Commission is required to act on the applications within a specified time period or the applications are automatically approved.

2. AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ADVISE EACH APPLICANT OF THE COMMISSION'S ACTION TO DENY AND OF THE APPLICANTS' RIGHT TO REAPPLY FOR A PERMIT.

W 21237	Fathom 8 Corporation	Salvage Permit
	Applicant has not responded in a timely manner to staff inquiries relative to lease provisions. It appears that the applicant is unable to complete project development. No salvage activity has occurred to date. A 90-day extension was previously granted.	
W 21504	U.S. Bureau of Reclamation	Existing fish spawning riffles in the Trinity River
	Applicant is unwilling to accept standard permit terms and conditions and will not execute Commission permit documents. Staff will continue to negotiate with applicant to resolve concerns. A 90-day extension was previously granted.
