GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT: Walker Boudwin Construction Co., Inc.
P.O. Box 2544
Reno, Nevada 89502

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.045 acre circular parcel, 50 feet in
diameter, of submerged lands in Carnelian
Bay, Lake Tahoe, Placer County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of one mooring buoy for recreational
boating.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 15 years from January 1,
1980.

Surety bond: \$500.

Public liability insurance: combined single
limit coverage of \$100,000
per occurrence for bodily
injury and property damage.

Special: The permit is conditioned
on permittee's conformance
with the Shorezone Ordinances
of California Tahoe Regional
Planning Agency and Tahoe
Regional Planning Agency.

CONSIDERATION: \$30.00 per annum with the State reserving
the right to fix a different rental on
each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PRE-REQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee has been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

This facility is subject to the jurisdiction of the California Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board, and the County of Placer. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.

2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO WALKER BOUDWIN CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. OF A 15-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE FROM JANUARY 1, 1980; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30.00, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT; WITH PROVISION OF A \$500 SURETY BOND; AND WITH PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$100,000 PER OCCURRENCE OF BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE FOR MAINTENANCE OF ONE MOORING BUOY UTILIZED FOR RECREATIONAL BOATING ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

WP 5074

A parcel of submerged land in the bed of Lake Tahoe, Placer County, California, being more particularly described as follows:

That parcel of land included within the circumference of a circle having a radius of 25 feet and being adjacent to Lot 20, Block B as shown on the Map of "Carnelian Bay on Lake Tahoe", filed in the office of the county recorder of said county on January 6, 1908, in Book C of Maps, page 14, the center of said parcel is located 50 feet northerly of a point on the easterly extension of the southerly line of said Lot 20 that is 290 feet easterly of the southwesterly corner of said Lot 20.

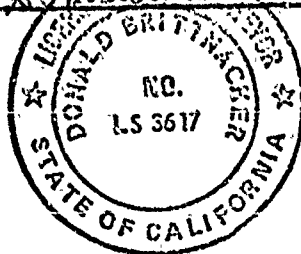

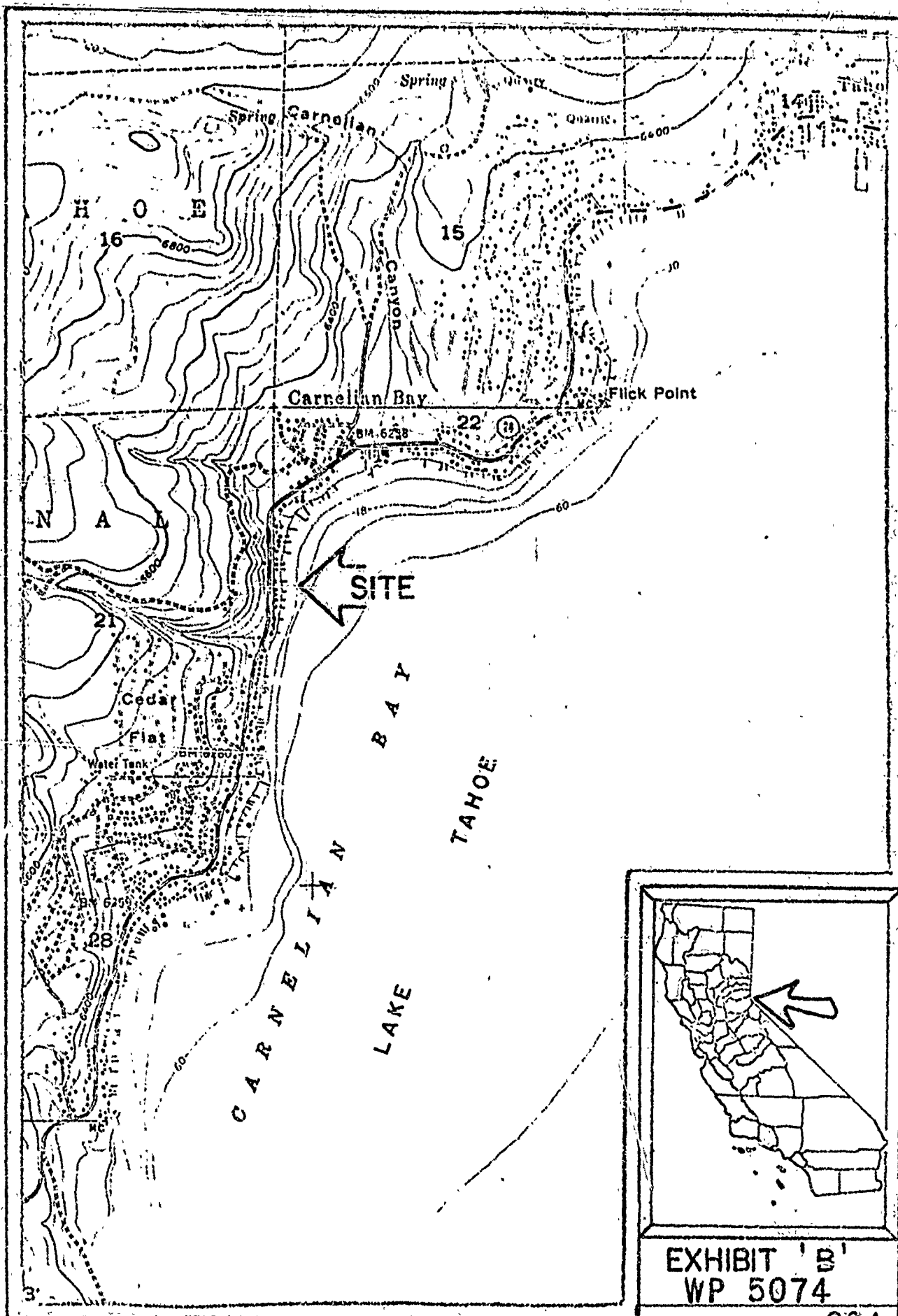
