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CALENDAR ITEM NO. CA (CONTD)

- This project is exempt from CEQA because it is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15106 (6c) (Information Collection)
- This project is situated on land identified as possessing environmental values in that the State Lands Commission stated all waterways under the Commission's jurisdiction have environmental significance. Staff finds this project to be compatible with Commission policy.
- The Water and Power Resources Services (formerly United States Bureau of Reclamation) is the lead agency in an intergovernmental study to determine "best environmental management alternatives" for the Suisun Marsh. Other agencies involved in the study include the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, Soil Conservation, and the California Departments of Fish and Game and Water Resources. Accordingly, staff recommends waiver of normal processing fees.
