DREDGING PERMIT (Maintenance)

APPLICANT:

City of Richmond City Hall Richmond, California 94804

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: State-owned granted tide and submerged Lands (minerals reserved) in San Francisco Ray, Port of Richmond Terminal No. 4, Contra Costa County.

LAND USE: Dredge 32,000 cubic yards of material in two increments of 16,000 cubic yards each for maintaining berthing facility at -35 feet MLLW. Spoils will be deposited at at the Corps of Engineers Alcatraz Disposal site.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT: Initial Period: 5 years from January 1, 1980.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit. Royalty \$0.25/cu.yd. in the event dredged material is sold.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee has been received.

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STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES: A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

B. Cal. Adm. Code; Title 2, Div. 3.

OTHER PERTINEN'T INFORMATION:

1. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

2. This project is exempt from CEQA because it consists of minor alterations to land (maintenance dredging).

United States Army Corps of Engineers, San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission, California Regional Water Quality Control Board.




IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
- 2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
- 3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CITY OF RICHMOND OF A 5-YEAR MAINTENANCE DREDGING PERMIT FROM JANUARY 1, 1980, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT; FOR DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 32,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA OF GRANTED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, AND TO SPOIL SUCH MATERIALS IN THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS ALCATRAZ DISPOSAL SITE AND IN THE EVENT MATERIALS ARE SOLD, A ROYALTY OF 0.25 CENTS PER CUBIC YARD WILL BE CHARGED.

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
