CONTINUATION OF LEASE RENTAL AFTER ROUTINE REVIEW

This is Right-of-Way Lease for a term of 25 years from May 20, 1970, with an existing armual rent of \$100.00 covering 0.548 acres being one parcel of submerged land in the Klamath River, Del Norte County, for operation and maintenance of a 12.5 KV overhead transmission line crossing. The staff recommends continuation of the existing rental for the next years.

This action is exempt from CEQA because it is not a project as defined within the State EIR guidelines.

AUTHORITY: 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2903(d).

The lease provides that the State may adjust the annual rental at a different amount for the 5-year term following the fifth anniversary of the lease, effective on such anniversary date. Staff's valuation analysis indicates that the minimum rental for this type facility should continue to apply.

BASIS FOR CONTINUED RENTAL:

\$100.00 minimum rental for this type of lease.
