RENEWAL OF RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

Two contiguous parcels near Alvarado, Alameda

County, to wit:

Parcel 1: 0.392 acre at Alameda Creek. Parcel 2: 0.273 acre at Alameda Creek

Flood Control Channel.

LAND USE:

Overhead Transmission Line.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL AGREEMENT:

15 years from January 10, 1963. Initial period:

Renewal options:

3 successive periods

of 10 years each.

Consideration:

\$300.90 total rental

for 15 year term.

TERMS OF PROPOSED RENEVAL:

10 years from January 10, Initial period;

1978.

\$100.00 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on CONSIDERATION:

each fifth anniversary of the Agreement.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Minimum rental for this type of Agreement.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee has been received.

BACKGROUND:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied for a renewal of its overhead transmission-

line easement across Alameda Creek, one

mile west of Alvarado, in Alameda County (as shown on Exhibit "A"). The issuance of the Original Easement Agreement was authorized by the Commission at its meeting of March 31, 1966, Minute Item No. 9.

The land is part of an exchange of lands with Leslie Salt Company, which was consummated on January 10, 1963, and the transmission line was installed during the period of negotiations.

The easement area consists of two parcels, as follows:

Parcel 1 encompasses 0.392 acres of land acquired by the State in exchange with Leslie Salt Company, and is encombered by a perpetual easement granted to the applicant prior to acceptance by the State. This parcel is incorporated in the agreement for record purposes only; rental terms, and other terms of the agreement, do not apply to Parcel 1, inasmuch as PG & E secured its right in the property in advance of State Lands Commission interests.

Parcel 2 encompasses 0.273 acre of land contiguous to the above land and unencumbered, being part of the original bed of Alameda Creek.

## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

2. This project is situated on State land which has not been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1; however, the State Lands Commission has stated that all waterways under the Commission's jurisdiction have environmental significance. Staff finds this project to be compatible with Commission policy.

- AUTHORIZE IGSUANCE TO THE PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY OF A TEN YEAR RENEWAL OF RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT PRO 3462.1 FROM JANUARY 10, 1978; IN CC., SIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100.00, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE AGREEMENT FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF AN EXISTING OVERHEAD TRANSMISSION LINE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

ACROSS SOVEREIGN LANDS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA S. 20° 20' 52" E.,


