OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

- 2. The project does not qualify for RPP since upland is not used primarily for single family residence.
- 3. The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended the granting of permits for new construction at Lake Tahoe. The application herein is for continued use of existing buoys in the Lake, and therefore is not subject to the suspension of granting permits for new construction.
- An EIR is not required. This transactions is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1B, which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property or other types of environmental degradation.
