OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation,
- This project is situated on State land 2. identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.
- The Commission, at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended the granting of permits for new construction at Lake Tahoe. The application herein is for continued use of an existing pier in the Lake, and therefore is not subject to the Commission's suspension of granting permits for new construction.
- Back rent in the amount of \$130 covering the period between the dates of application of September 25, 1976, and the permit date of January 1, 1980, is to be waived since the delay was not the fault of the applicant, but due to administrative revisions and changes.

Together with a necessary use area extending no more than 10 feet from the extremities of said pier, said pier being adjacent to and easterly of Lots 2 and 3, McKinney Shores Subdivision, as shown on the map thereof, filed June 26, 1961 in Book "G" of Maps, Page 25, Official Records of Placer County.

Excepting therefrom any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water line of Lake Tahoe.
