RESCISSION OF PRIOR AUTHORIZATION AND APPROVAL OF GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

Jeanne Buttimer 115 Harbor Drive

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 2,587 square foot parcel of tide and

submerged land in Petaluma River, Blackpoint,

Marin County

LAND USE:

Maintenance of an existing walkway, shed,

platforms and float.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

10 years from March 1, 1977.

Public liability insurance: Combined single fimit coverage of \$100,000.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$30.00 fixed rental for this type of permit, in addition to rent free facilities arsuant to P.R.C. Section 6503.5.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and first two year's rental have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Changes in regulations during the processing of this General Permit Recreational Use have occurred; therefore, staff is requesting the Commission rescind its prior authorization and approve a new permit which reflects the current regulations.
 - The action proposed herein will permit the walkway and float to be rent-free pursuant to PRC 6503.5. This reflects a change in the annual rental consideration from \$50 per year to \$30 per year.
- 2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO JEANNE BUTTIMER OF A 10-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE FROM MARCH 1, 1977; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30.00, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FEX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT; PROVISION OF COMBINED SINGZE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$100,000; FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF TWO EXISTING PLATFORMS AND SHED AND FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A RENT FREE WALKWAY AND FLOAT PURSUANT TO PPC 6503.5 ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
