CONTINUATION OF LEASE RENTAL AFTER ROUTINE REVIEW

LESSEE:

E: Pacific Gas and Electric Company 77 Beale Street San Francisco, California 94106

This is a Right-of-Way Lease for a term of 15 years from January 14, 1976, with an existing annual rent of \$100, covering a 0.350 acre parcel of tide and submerged lands in Walthall Slough near Manteca, San Joaquin County, for maintenance of an overhead 17 kv electrical line utilized for the transmission of electrical energy. A routine review of the lease by staff indicates that a revision of the rental is not warranted under current regulations and that the \$100 minimum rental for this lease should be continued.

This activity is exempt from CEQA because it is not a project as defined within the State EIR Guidelines.

Authority: 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15060, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2903(d).

The lease provides that the State may adjust the annual rental at a different amount for the 5-year term following the fifth anniversary of the lease, effective on such anniversary date.

The lessee was notified of the proposed rental within the time constraints set by his lease.

BASIS FOR CONTINUED RENTAL: \$100 minimum rental for this type of lease.
