Staff feels that shore protection at

this location will be of mutual benefit

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to both the public and the applicant. The shoreline will have additional protection at no cost to the public.

3. An EIR is not required. A portion of this transaction is within the purview of Title 14 Cal. Adm. Code Section 15101, which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

The remaining portion of the project is exempt from CEQA because it involves minor alteration in the condition of land and water and construction of a new small structure.

Authority: Title 14 Cal. Adm. Code Sections 15103 and 15104.

- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use. Staff feels this activity is compatible with the significant environmental values.
- 5. The project includes construction of a cement baluster on top of an existing cobblestone shoreline revetment and construction of a cement base revetment three feet seaward of the existing revetment.
- 6. This project has been approved with conditions by the California Coastal Commission.
- 7. Because of the uncertainty of the State's title in this area, it is recommended that expense and processing fees be waived.
