AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

0.30-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River situated near Freeport, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Operation of a commercial boating facility.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: 5 years from October 1;

1965.

Renewal options: 3 successive periods

of 10 years each.

Surety bond: \$2,000.

Public liability insurance: \$100,000/ 300,000 per occurrence

for bodily injury and

\$5,000 for property damage.

Consideration: \$150.

TERMS OF PROPOSED REPLACEMENT LEASE:

Initial period: 20 years from October 1.

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CONSIDERATION: \$400 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

Applicant is owner of upland.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The original lease is being terminated, effective September 30, 1980, and a replacement lease is being issued, effective October 1, 1980, which reflects current leasing policy.
- 2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
