AUTHORIZATION TO FILE DISCLAIMER ON SIGNAL HILL REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

SHELL OIL COMPANY, ET AL., LOS ANGELES COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT, NO. 331340

The State Lands Commission is a party to a condemnation action brought by the Signal Hill Redevelopment Agency entitled, Signal Hill Redevelopment Agency v. Shell Oil Company, Et Al., filed in the Los Angeles County Superfor Court, Civil No. 331340, involving land in Los Angeles County to be used in connection with appurtenant structures in, over, under, across and through those tracts which are the subject of this condemnation action, a temporary construction easement for road purposes in, over, under, across, along and through the parcels that are the subject of this condemnation action, and an easement for road and public utility purposes in, over, under, across, and through those parcels that are the subject of this condemnation action.

Upon examination of the presently existing Commission's records pertinent to the area, it has been ascertained that there is no interest held by the State mands Commission as to the tract of land described in the Notice of Condemnation.

Inasmuch as this suit involves lands over which the Commission has no jurisdiction, it is recommended that a Disclaimer be filed on behalf of the State Lands Commission disclaiming any compensable right, title, or interest in those tracts of the subject condemnation.
