GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: California Department of Fish and Game
350 Golden Shore
Long Beach, California 90802

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
0.57-acre submerged land in the Pacific
Ocean, (Monterey Bay) offshore from Soquel
Cove, Santa Cruz County.

LAND USE: Artificial fishing reef.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 49 years from March 1,
1981.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit with the State
reserving the right at any time to set
a monetary rental if the Commission finds
such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Filing fee and processing fees have been
received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:
A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2; Div. 13;
Div. 20.
B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3; Title 14,

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
1. The annual rental value of the site
is estimated to be \$1000.
2. This project is exempt from CEQA because
it falls within the provisions of Title 14,
Section 15104, Class 4, (minor alterations
to land).

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3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class "C", which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

4. The project has been determined by the Coastal Commission to be compatible with their requirements, and a permit has been issued.
5. The project will promote public recreational use of the ocean, as it will enhance sport diving and fishing opportunities.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5, OF TITLE 2, OF THE CAL. ADM. CODE.
3. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 49-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE - FROM MARCH 1, 1981; IN CONSIDERATION OF

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THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR AN ARTIFICIAL FISHING REEF, ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

W 22472

A triangular shaped parcel of submerged land situated in Monterey Bay, Santa Cruz County, California, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the point of west longitude $121^{\circ}57'18''$ and north latitude $36^{\circ}56'42''$; then the following three courses:

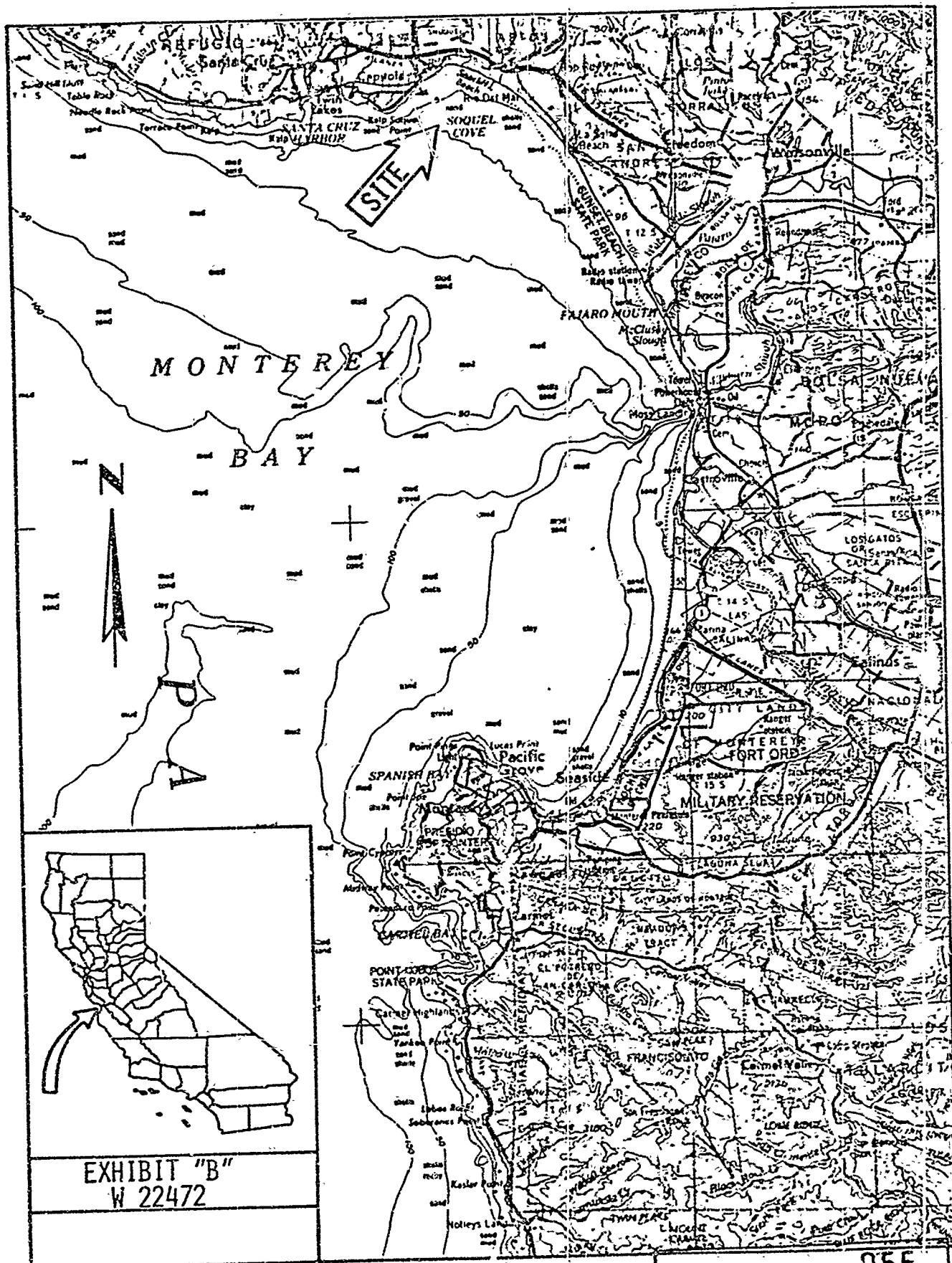
1. South 240 feet
2. N 60° W 240 feet
3. N 60° E 240 feet to point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying within the grant to the County of Santa Cruz, per Chapter 1655, Statutes of 1970.
