GENERAL PERMIT - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE

APPLICANT: Fred J. and Edith Fearrien  
P. O. Box 26  
Fernbridge, California 95540

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
A 0.313-acre parcel of tide and submerged  
land on Quill Slough, Humboldt County.

LAND USE: Construction and maintenance of a tidegate,  
levee repair, and placement of rock riprap.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Initial period: 30 years from February 1,  
1981.

CONSIDERATION: No monetary consideration required, the  
public benefit will accrue, with the State  
reserving the right at any time to set  
a monetary rental if the Commission finds  
such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:  
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:  
Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been  
received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:  
A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2; Div. 13;  
Div. 20.  
B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3; Title 14,  
Div. 6.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:  
1. The annual rental value of the site  
is estimated to be \$470.  
2. The project involves the construction  
and maintenance of a tide gate and

culvert to drain leveed farm pasture lands adjacent to Quill Slough, Humboldt County, repair of the existing levee, which has been severely eroded, and the placement of rock riprap on the levee bank for protection. These activities are exempt from CEQA as repair of existing facilities and minor alteration to land.

Authority: 14 Cal. Adm. Code Sections 15102 and 15104.

3. Staff feels that maintenance and protection of the existing levee bank at this location will be of continuing mutual benefit to both the public and the applicant. The additional bank protection will protect the levee from wave and water flow erosion. The applicant will continue to benefit from the protection of their agricultural lands.
4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use. Staff finds the proposed project to be consistent with such designation.

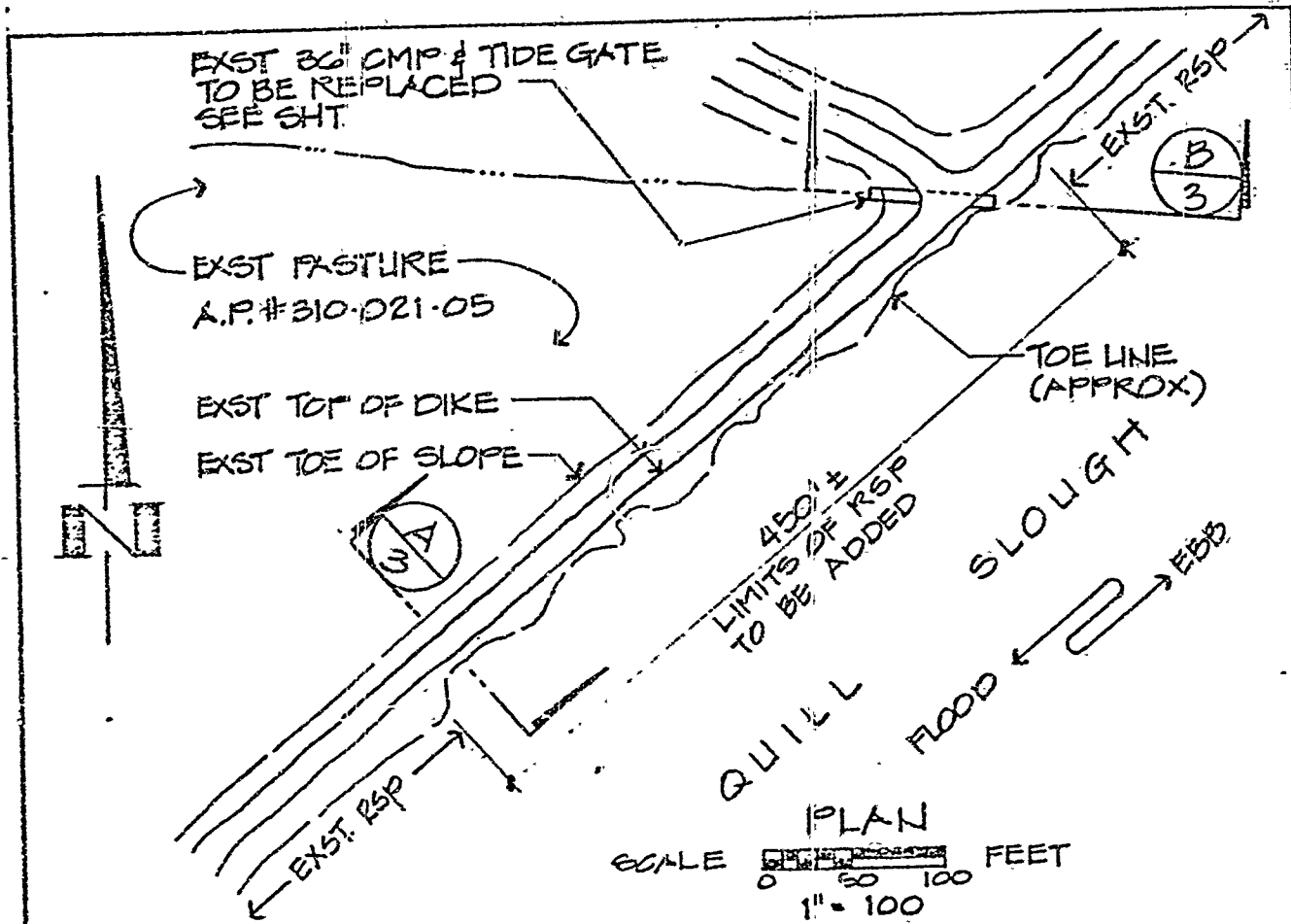

2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5, OF TITLE 2, OF THE CAL. ADM. CODE.

3. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO FRED J. AND EDITH FEARRIEN OF A 30-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE FROM FEBRUARY 1, 1981; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A TIDEGATE, LEVEE REPAIR AND PLACEMENT OF ROCK RIPRAP ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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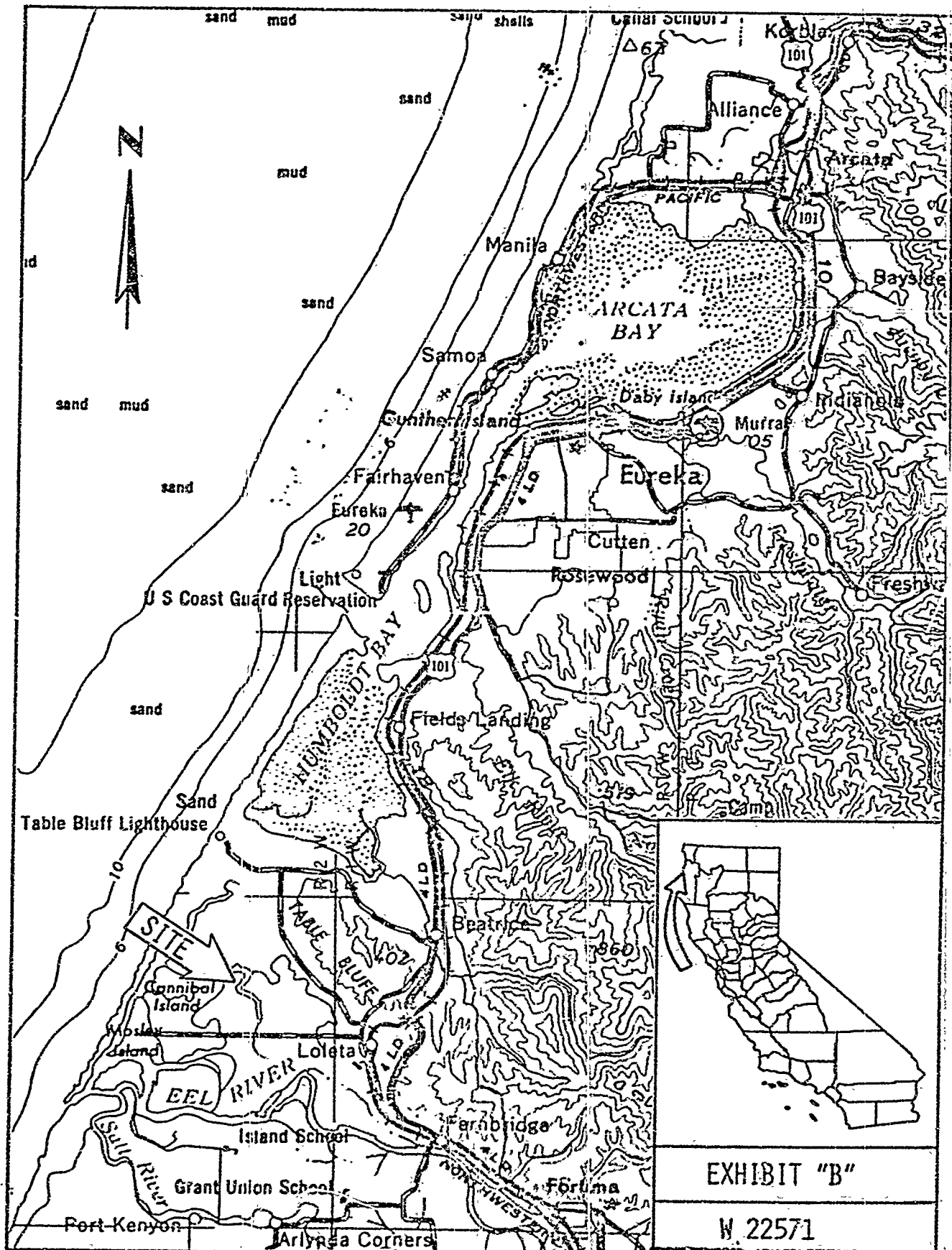
