OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline exosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

- 3. The proposed lease is for maintenance of an existing pier and appurtenant pipeline which connects the applicant's State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 429 with onshore facilities.
- 4. The pier is owned and used by Mobil Oil Corporation and Norris Oil Co. The staff is processing a separate lease with Mobil for the use of State land.
