CONTINUATION OF LEASE RENTAL AFTER ROUTINE REVIEW

LESSEE:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company P. O. Box 7444 Sacramento, Galifornia 95826

This is a Right-of-Way lease for a term of 49 years from November 1, 1971 with an existing annual rent of \$100 covering a 0.179-acre parcel of tide and submerged lands in the South Fork of the Mokelumne River, San Joaquin County, for maintenance of a 21 KV submarine cable.

The lease provides that the State may adjust the annual rental at a different amount for the 5-year term following the tenth anniversary of the lease effective on such anniversary date.

This activity is exempt from CEQA because it is not a project as defined within the State EIR Guidelines.

Authority:

14 Cal. Adm. Code 15037 and 15060.

Routine review of the lease by staff indicates a change in the rental is not warranted at this time.

BASIT FOR CONTINUED RENTAL:

\$100 minimum rental for this type of lease.

The lessee was notified of the amount within the time constraints set by this lease.
