OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- 2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15103, Class 3(d), which exempts new construction of small structures.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

4. At the September, 1981, meeting the Commission concurred in the Issuance of a Letter of Permission to PT and T to enter upon the lands described here in for a period of 60 days to construct, operate and maintain these telephone and telegraph facilities.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

This facility is subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, California Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, California Reclamation Board and the Counties of Sacramente and San Joaquin. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agricus having jurisdiction.
